OUR STORY

- 1888 Yom Bisalayaputr, the former owner of the building, bought up land in the Silom area. Later, he started to build the canal and roads and then sold the land to others. From his accomplishments in the community, he was granted the title "Luang Sathorn Rajayutka" by King Rama V.
- 1889 It is assumed that Luang Sathorn Rajayutka constructed the building on this land in 1889.
- 1895 Luang Sathorn Rajayutka passed away with cholera at the age of 38.
- 1896 The ownership of the building and the land were passed on to his eldest daughter, Cham. Later, Cham got married with a Hainanese man, Luang Chitrchumnongvanich (Thomya Rongavanit), who then took charge of all Luang Sathorn Rajayutka's businesses.
- 1916 Luang Chitrchumnongvanich sold this building and the land to the King's private holding and moved out from the building.
- 1925 The building was given to Chaophraya Ramrakhop by King Rama VI.
- 1926 Chaophraya Ramrakhop sold the land with the building to the King's private holding. After that, the building was lent to an Italian lady, Madame A. Staro and became "Hotel Royal".
- 1948 From 1948 - 1999, The building was leased to the Soviet Union as the first Russian Embassy in Thailand.
- 2001 The Department of Fine Arts issued an official statement announcing the building as a registered national archeological site.
- 2003 The building is leased to North Sathorn Hotel Co., Ltd (W Bangkok). The company started to renovate the building along with consultation from the Department of Fine Arts. In 2015, The House on Sathorn was reopened as part of W Bangkok.
- 2022 The work of today is the history of tomorrow and we are all part of it.



THE PRESENT

The House on Sathorn is a beautifully preserved example of Bangkok's colonial era architecture. Although it sits surrounded by towering modern buildings, its magnificent design still commands the attention of passersby. In 2001, it was registered with Thailand's Department of Fine Arts as an archaeological site and heritage landmark. Two years later the property was incorporated into the adjacent W Bangkok hotel (and given its current name).

These days, The House on Sathorn is most well-known for its modern Thai seafood restaurant Paii, a 2-floor indoor and outdoor courtyard restaurant with private dining, as well as Bar Sathorn, a timeless drink destination.

However, the complex is also home to The Conservatory, Hospitality Suites, and The Loft, all ideally suited for meetings and social gatherings.

Commemorating the present day modern property, while at the same time creating a link to the past, all beverages in this section each highlight one specific Thai ingredient.

EMBASSY ROW

Sathorn Road experienced a substantial period of growth starting in the late 1800's, around the same time when The House on Sathorn was first constructed. In the period that followed, this area continued to grow, with many foreign offices, ports, and medical centres popping up; including BNH, the Kingdom's first international standard private hospital (which opened 1898 and was originally called the Bangkok Nursing Home).

Sathorn gradually became one of the most prestigious parts of Bangkok, finding success not only as a commercial district but also as the preferred address for a number of prominent foreign embassies. In fact, from 1948 to 1999 the heritage mansion now known as The House on Sathorn served as the site of the first Soviet — and later Russian — Embassy in Thailand.

Nowadays, Sathorn Road is home to the British Embassy, as well as the embassies of Malaysia, Belgium, Myanmar, Greece, Singapore, Denmark, and Germany. Needless to say, this busy thoroughfare came to be known locally as 'Embassy Row'.




HOTEL ROYAL

In the mid-1920s, an enterprising Italian lady known as Madame A. Staro transformed this building into the ultra-luxurious Hotel Royal. Postcards, faded photos, and old advertisements in newspapers such as The Straits Times of Singapore, all attest to the hotel's popularity. However, it's an anecdote in the four-volume autobiography of Phya Anuman Rajadhon – a noted Thai folklore scholar – that adds some important extra details. In the first volume of his Fuen Kwam Lung (roughly translated as "recollections"), he describes how his Italian friend took him to Hotel Royal for an Italian meal, and there he met the enigmatic Madame Staro.

Interestingly, a 1927 Bangkok guidebook published by The Royal State Railway Department of Siam includes the Hotel Royal in its accommodation section, describing it as "fully equipped, well-furnished, and in a good location". It's a description that still rings true, and these four unique concoctions celebrate this wonderfully glamorous chapter in the life of the building.



HISTORY OF SATHORN

The history of The House on Sathorn is intertwined with the history of Sathorn Road itself. Constructed in 1889, during the reign of King Rama V, it was originally a private home owned by Yom Bisalayaputr (or Chao Sua Yom), a wealthy Chinese businessman who engineered the digging of what would become the Sathorn Canal. This new route greatly improved transportation within the city, and the King granted Yom Bisalayaputr the title "Luang Sathorn Rajayutka", which is why the canal, and now the road, bears the name "Sathorn".

Built in colonial style, on a spacious compound, the businessman's grand residence consisted of four separate buildings enclosing a magnificent courtyard. Woven into its neoclassical design were two recurring symbols: the boar, which referenced Luang Sathorn Rajayukta's Chinese zodiac birth year; and the Chinese rice flower, supposedly the favorite of the lady of the house.

To honor this amazing historic legacy, these four specially created drinks pay tribute to the building's earliest known origins.




